Introduction: It is later on the first day of the week...two travelers, going home to Emmaus are very troubled...Jesus answers their questions and made Himself known to them...

I. Their Troubling Questions

A. Who are These Two Travelers?

B. They've heard Jesus Teaching and had hoped He was the Messiah...

C. They didn't recognize Jesus...

Observation: Jesus didn't always appear in the same form... *John 20:17 cf. 21:27; Mark 16:12*

D. Jesus Presses them to tell him their Concerns...

Lesson: Consider the value of a sympathizing ear...

E. Their Concerns are summarized ...

Observation: Nothing makes sense...they stumble at the cross...

II. Jesus Answers Their Concerns...

A. A Word of Rebuke... "O foolish ones..."

B. His sermon to them, vs. 27

C. His purpose unfolded... vs. 26

Lesson: This is our message!

A. Their Hearts burned with interest and desire...

B. They Remembered His words... They had saving faith...

III. Jesus Gracious and Wonderful Revelation of Himself at Emmaus...

A. They arrived, too soon for them...

B. They fellowshiped around the table...

C. Jesus blessed and broke the bread...

D. Their eyes were opened...
