The Body Divided

Why is there so much division/disunity in the body of Christ?

Why is it that while we are contending for the faith, we become contentious with the faithful?

1. Flesh
 - We defend unity at the expense of biblical truth.
 - We emphasize specific issues at the expense of balance.
2. Pride (Prov. 13:10)
 - If contention exists in the church, someone became proud.
3. Fear
 - We are afraid of being identified with people who might do things differently than we do.

1. Grow _____ (v. 15)
 - There is only one body of Christ, made up of "local expressions."
2. Grow _____ (v. 16)

- Every true believer is a *member* of the body.
- Without accountability, the Christian life is optional.
- God knows how to make a body. (1 Cor. 12:12-31)
 - "But as it is, God arranged the members in the body, each one of them, as he chose" (v. 18).
 - Rather than complain about being or not being in certain positions, accept that God places you as it pleases Him.

3. Grow _____ (v. 16b)

- Most churches try to grow out before they grow up and grow together.
