Consider & Discuss (Be Transformed!)

• Community Group Discussion: What does Paul mean that "flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God (50)? In v. 51 was Paul dispelling and mystery or describing what is still a mystery about the resurrection? Considering meaning of word "changed" along with the context, what does Paul mean in vv. 51 and 52, "...we shall all be changed"? What is the event/time of "the last trumpet" (52)? NASB note says "Perishable" = Literally "corruptible"; and "imperishable" = "incorruptible". What is the difference and what change is Paul indicating will come upon us at the resurrection? Likewise what is the change Paul is indicating will come upon the Christian and the resurrection when moral puts on immortality (53.54)? Pastor Kit has called the "death is swallowed up in victory" as the death of death. With what you know of the creation, fall and promised of redemption in the larger Biblical story line, in what sense is death swallowed up in victory? Unpack "the sting of death is sin". How are Christians given victory through Jesus (57). All that discussed, how does this help us understand resurrection?
