2 Chronicles 14 — "How to Start an Activity in a Good & God-Honoring Way: Lessons from King Asa" Introduction

In 2 Chronicles 14-16 – a UNIT on Asa (a good, Davidic king: followed God & HIs Law)

- 1. Asa's **CONFIDENCE** in God (ch. 14) // recognition of God
- 2. Asa's **CONSECRATION** to God (ch. 15) // reformation toward God
- 3. Asa's **CAPITULATION** from God (ch. 16) // rebellion against God

**THESIS** — So how do you start something good and make it God-honoring?? From this account, we'll glean **4 guides to help** in starting something new and making it God-honoring.

### I.BEGIN BY PURSUING GOD! (1-2)

Perhaps the defining mark of a true Christian: a pursuer of God: one who runs after God!

# II.BEGIN BY SLAYING SIN! (3-8)

B. PURSUE GOD (vv.4ff)

## III. BEGIN BY EXPECTING OPPOSITION! (9)

Consider Acts 14:22 — "Through many tribulations we must enter the kingdom of God."

### IV.BEGIN BY TRUSTING GOD! (10-15)

- Trusting GOD is \*always\* the wisest path to choose. [Ps 62.8 trust in Him at all times, O peoples!!]
- Even against ALL possible and conceivable odds, when everyone turns against you & calls it a foolish thing to do: trust God & continue TRUSTING in God.

#### Asa's prayer we see the following:

- I. Invoke the Covenant-Name of Jehovah ("LORD...")
- 2. Remember the Exclusivity of Jehovah ("there is no one besides you")
- 3. Plead for the Help of Jehovah ("no one to help between powerful ... so HELP us!")
- 4. Reaffirm your Belonging to Jehovah ("our God")
- 5. Triumph in Trust in Jehovah ('we trust in you")
- 6. Reflect the Glory of Jehovah ("in your name we have come...")
- 7. Verbalize the Sovereignty of Jehovah ("let no man prevail against you")

So we see that he called upon God & His covenantal-love (LORD), exclusivity (no one besides you), ability (no one to help), nearness/imminency (so help us), personal (help us O LORD OUR GOD), trustworthy (we trust in you) & a personal affirmation (you are OUR GOD)!

If it was this way historically with Asa & His covenant people, <u>HOW MUCH MORE</u> with us as His redeemed, blood-bought children!

GOD gives us the victory: in Christ we conquer; He is our Victor; our Atonement!

God gives us a **GRACIOUS** victory (all of grace/undeserved)

God gives us an ETERNAL victory (once for all)

God gives us a **REWARDING** victory (plundered them)

God gives us the **CHOICEST** victory (heavenly inheritance; every spiritual blessing)

Christ gives us the choicest of gifts: eternal inheritance in glory (forever!)

Conclusion

Deuteronomy 4:29 reminds us as Moses told Israel: "you will seek the LORD your God, and you will find Him if you search for Him with all your heart and all your soul."
