1. It's better to be content than envious.

2. It's better to be in community than by yourself.

3. It's better to be teachable than prideful.

4. Because this is the better path that Jesus has for His disciples.

Proverbs 6:10-11 10 A little sleep, a little slumber, A little folding of the hands to sleep— 11 So shall your poverty come on you like a prowler, And your need like an armed man. (NKJV)

Philippians 4:11-12 11 Not that I speak in regard to need, for I have learned in whatever state I am, to be content: 12 I know how to be abased, and I know how to abound. Everywhere and in all things I have learned both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. (NKJV)
