Sermon Outline

An Outpouring of the Spirit Acts 2:1-41

Introduction: Wind, Fire, and the Spirit of God

Two Questions about Pentecost:

- 1. Who or what is the Holy Spirit?
- 2. What exactly is the miracle of tongues at Pentecost?

Five Observations from this Passage that Clarify the Purpose of Pentecost:

- 1. The preparation for the pouring out of the Spirit is God's people, gathered together, in obedience to Christ's command and in unity with one another. (v1)
- 2. The source for the pouring out of the Spirit is in heaven, and not on earth. (v2-4)
- 3. The result of the pouring out of the Spirit is to gather in people from all nations. (v5-13)
- 4. The goal of the pouring out of the Spirit is the preaching of the gospel of Jesus Christ. (v14-36)
- 5. The evidence of the pouring out of the Spirit is repentance toward God, faith in the Lord Jesus, and the building up of Christ's church. (v37-41)

Application: Believe that the Spirit of God Is Able to Revive Us Again!
