is a call to complete, ongoing, and lifelong commitment and devotion to the will of God in Christ.	
• This flies in the face of the majority of our culture, where self-definition and	
self-realization is the driving force of self-fulfillment.	
*The <i>challenge to apply</i> our Christ-following cross-bearing at two levels:  * <i>Macro</i> - a whole life commitment and submission to Jesus	
• Micro - the daily acts of love, service, humility, confession, etc.
