2. Set your heart on Christ and the great hope He gives.



16 having a good conscience, so that, when you are slandered, those who revile your good behavior in Christ may be put to shame. (ESV)






17 For it is better, if the will of God be so, that ye suffer for well doing, than for evil doing. KJV

17 For it is better to suffer for doing good, if that should be God's will, than for doing evil. (ESV)






## 1.Suffering for the Sake of Righteousness 3:13-14a

And who is he that will harm you, if ye be followers of that which is good? [14a] But and if ye suffer for righteousness' sake, happy are ye....





"... be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear."


