**A.W. Pink** "So inconceivable, so immense, so uncontrollable is the power of the Deity, that the fearful convulsions which he works in nature conceal more than they reveal of his infinite might!"

**Mark 16:42** 62 Jesus said, "I am. And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven." (NKJV)

**A.W. Pink** "We cannot have a right conception of God unless we think of him as all-powerful ... He who cannot do what he will and perform all his pleasure cannot be God."

**Matthew 3:9** 9 And do not think to say to yourselves, "We have Abraham as *our* father.' For I say to you that God is able to raise up children to Abraham from these stones. (NKJV)

**Stephen Charnock** "As holiness is the beauty of all God's attributes, so power is that which gives life and action to all the perfections of the Divine nature."

**Genesis 18:14** 14 Is anything too hard for the LORD? At the appointed time I will return to you, according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son." (NKJV)

**John 6:37** 37 All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out. (NKJV)

**1 Peter 1:5** 5 [You] are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. (NKJV)

**Philippians 3:21** 21 [Jesus] will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself. (NKJV)

**A.W. Pink** "If God were stunted in might and had a limit to his strength we might well despair. But seeing that he is clothed with omnipotence, no prayer is too hard for him to answer, no need too great for him to supply, no passion too strong for him to subdue; no temptation too powerful for him to deliver from, no misery too deep for him to relieve."
