

Faith Working – The Godly Witness of Noah (Hebrews 11:7;)

- Paul professed faith in Christ – then “*Lord what do you want me to do*”

I. Noah’s Faith & Experience were without Precedent

- Noah’s significance in Scripture, grace & righteousness: 1st time re Noah
- Declaration of worldwide judgment is associated with Noah
- a. Noah as our precedent

II. Noah was Uncompromising in His faith

- a. The preciseness of his faith
- b. The persistence of his faith

III. He Was Unashamed

- a. Noah Trusted Christ
- b. Making the connection with your own faith

IV. It was Unambiguous

1. Noah was not hesitant: the text emphasizes Noah trusted God’s Word
2. Noah became a father after God’s announced judgment (*Gen 6:1-3, 18*)
3. Judgment fell when Noah was 600 years old (*Gen 7:6*)
 - a. His faith was protective
 - b. Avoiding cursed consequences
