Syllabus (414 Systematic Theology IV: Christology—3 credits)

I. Course Description

This course considers the doctrine of the person and work of Christ: the names, natures, offices, and states of the Mediator, as well as the atonement.

II. Course Objectives

By the end of the course, you should be able to:

- A. Define the key terms used in the discussion of Christology.
- B. Demonstrate an understanding of historical and current issues in Christological methodology.
- C. Explain the biblical teaching regarding the deity and sinless humanity of the Savior in the unity of His Person, and grasp the importance of these truths for the Christian faith.
- D. Defend the church's historic understanding of Christology from heretical views, such as Ebionism, Arianism, Docetism, Apollinarianism, Nestorianism, Eutychianism, Socinianism, Bultmannianism,
- E. Describe the biblical and historical evidence for the virgin birth of Christ, and understand its significance for understanding Christ's sinlessness, the supernatural, and Christian theology as a whole.
- F. Expound the prophetic, kingly, and priestly functions of Jesus Christ as they relate to believers and unbelievers.
- G. Explain the humiliation and exaltation stages of Christ's work.
- H. Explicate the major atonement theories, and identify the significance of Christ's atoning work as the Father-approved satisfaction and substitute for His people.

IV. Course Requirements
