• Exile: The Land

Messiah: 1<sup>st</sup> Coming:
 The Kingdom

• Messiah: 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming: The Kingdom

In every case God partially fulfills the Promises, enough to know He is supernaturally at work, but always leaving us to live by Hope in the final installment.

This is how to understand Ezekiel 36 (and all the prophets).

So the Spirit is a "down payment" of the Age to Come."

We always live by **HOPE**.
