A. Words are powerful

1. For bad:

James 3:6, 8 "the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell...the tongue can no man tame; it is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison"

Proverbs11:9 "An hypocrite with his mouth destroyeth his neighbor"

2. For good:

Proverbs 25:11"A word fitly spoken is like apples of gold in pictures/settings of silver"

3. Conclusion: Never undervalue words

Proverbs 18:21 "Death and life are in the power of the tongue"

B. Words need to be wise-Practically

-Listen before you respond

Proverbs 18:13 "He that answereth a matter before he heareth it, it is folly and shame unto him"

Proverbs 29:20 "Seest thou a man that is hasty in his words? there is more hope of a fool than of him"

-Weigh your words: Think before speaking

Proverbs 15:28 "The heart of the righteous studieth to answer: but the mouth of the wicked poureth out evil things"

James 1:26 "If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion is vain"

-Always speak truth

Proverbs 14:25 "A true witness delivereth souls: but a deceitful witness speaketh lies"

-Use edifying words

Proverbs 15:4 "A wholesome tongue is a tree of life"
