1. Behold, our God: Mighty in the purposes in suffering - Job 36:5-21
 - a. Suffering leads to final vindication of God's people
 - b. Suffering is corrective for God's children
 - c. Suffering is educational for God's children
 - d. Suffering is to produce submission in God's children
2. Behold, our God: Exalted in His powerful works - Job 36:22-24
 - a. God is the lofty, unrivaled, Teacher of teachers
 - b. Man is responsible to respond to the Teacher of teachers
 - c. Man cannot plead ignorance of the Teacher of teachers
3. Behold, our God: Great in His incomprehensible nature - Job 36:26-33
 - a. God is self-revealing
 - b. God is benevolent to all through common grace
4. Behold, our God: Great in the Power of His Word – Job 37
 - a. The power of God's Word displayed in nature

 - b. The power of God's Word applied in the new birth

 - d. End of the Matter: Be still, Behold God, Be humbled
