**2 Kings 13:5 (And the LORD gave Israel a saviour, so that they went out from under the hand of the Syrians...**

2 Kings 13:25 And Jehoash the son of Jehoahaz **took again** out of the hand of Benhadad the son of Hazael the cities, which he had taken out of the hand of Jehoahaz his father by war. Three times did Joash **beat him, and recovered** the cities of Israel.

**Nehemiah 9:27** Therefore thou deliveredst them into the hand of their enemies, who vexed them: and in the time of their trouble, when they cried unto thee, thou heardest them from heaven; and according to thy manifold mercies thou gavest them **saviours**, who **saved them out of the hand** of their enemies. 28...and many times didst thou **deliver them** according to thy mercies;

**Judges 3:9 And when the children of Israel cried unto the LORD, the LORD raised up **a deliverer** to the children of Israel, who delivered them, even Othniel the son of Kenaz, Caleb's younger brother.**

**"...a deliverer from death or ruin."**
