

7 times in chap 17, Jesus ASKED to be glorified (7x Son of God)

- 1) Regarding His Sonship (vs 1)
- 2) Regarding Appointed time (vs 1)
- 3) Regarding His power over all flesh (vs 2)
- 4) Regarding bestowal of E.L. (vs 2)
- 5) Regarding knowledge of Father (vs 3)
- 6) Regarding work He did on earth (vs 4)

7) Because He had finished the work God gave Him to do (vs 4)

33. 5 They answered him, Jesus of Nazareth. Jesus saith unto them, **I am he.** And Judas also, which betrayed him, stood with them.

6 As soon then as he had said unto them, **I am he,** they went backward, and fell to the ground.

7 Then asked he them again, Whom seek ye? And they said, Jesus of Nazareth. **On ground?**

8 Jesus answered, I have told you that **I am he;** if therefore ye seek me, let these go their way: **Terms**

9 That the saying might be fulfilled, which he spake, Of them which thou gavest me have I lost none. **17:2 Son honoring Father**

10 Then Simon Peter having a sword drew it, and smote the high priest's servant, and cut off his right ear. The servant's name was **Malchus.**

11 Then said Jesus unto Peter, Put up thy sword into the sheath: the **cup** which my Father hath given me, shall I not drink it?

Jesus brought before the high priest (Mt. 26. 57-68; Mk. 14. 53-65; Lk. 22. 66-71).

12 Then the band and the captain and officers of the Jews took Jesus, and bound him,

13 And led him away to **Annas first;** for he was father in law to Caiaphas, which was the high priest that same year.

14 Now Caiaphas was he, which gave counsel to the Jews, that it was expedient that one man should die for the people.

Peter is ready to die for Jesus, but not to live for him. **Rev 14:10** Cup of his indignation **MARK 11:36** take away cup

- 1) Renders soldiers help
- 2) Gives them orders (vs 8)
- 3) Protects them (vs 11)

2 King 1:10, 12 Elijah fire came down from heaven [2x Captain + 50]

11:50 one man should die **Luke 9:3** decrease to him he should accomplish

Peter did not follow Jesus - John (saw treatment of Jesus) **Luke 22:3** Satan desired siff **Luke 9:58** Son of man hath not where to lay his head

Peter not prepared **Rom 6:13** Neither yield ye your members... unto sin

1) I am he vs I am not

Prov 24:16 a just man falls seven times, riseth up again **Ps 1:1** blessed is the man

vs 5 Judas stood w/ the same crowd **18:25-27**

Peter's denial (also vs. 25-27) (Mt. 26. 69-75; Mk. 14. 66-72; Lk. 22. 54-62).

15 And Simon Peter followed Jesus, and so did another disciple: that disciple was known unto the high priest, and went in with Jesus into the **palace** of the high priest.

16 But Peter stood at the door without. Then went out that other disciple, which was known unto the high priest, and spake unto her that kept the door, and brought in Peter.

17 Then saith the damsel that kept the door unto Peter, Art not thou also one of this man's disciples? He saith, **I am not.** vs 5, 6, 8

18 And the servants and officers stood there, who had made a fire of coals; for it was cold: and they warmed themselves: and Peter stood with them, and warmed himself.

- getting comfortable w/ world
- getting a little colder - needs warming.

Peter

- vs 15 - followed Jesus
- vs 16 - But distanced himself
- vs 18 - Peter stood w/ enemies (company)
- vs 25-27 Peter denied Lord (switched sides)

APPLYING Truth to MIND - NOT Force

- only Power put forth in restraining wicked,
- in convincing the sinner
- in converting the heart,
- in guiding and leading His people
- and in sanctifying them

18 19]

20 Jesus answered him, I spake openly to the world; I ever taught in the synagogues, and in the temple, whither the Jews always resort; and in secret have I said nothing.

21 Why askest thou me? ask them which heard me, what I have said unto them: behold, they know what I said. **Ask the witnesses**

22 And when he had thus spoken, one of the officers which stood by struck Jesus with the palm of his hand, saying, Answerest thou the high priest so? **Heb 7:26** high priest

23 Jesus answered him, If I have spoken evil, bear witness of the evil: but if well, why smitest thou me?

24 Now Annas had sent him bound unto Caiaphas the high priest. (vs 13)

25 And Simon Peter stood and warmed himself. They said therefore unto him, Art not thou also one of his disciples? He denied it, and said, I am not.

26 One of the servants of the high priest, being his kinsman whose ear Peter cut off, saith, Did not I see thee in the garden with him?

27 Peter then denied again: and immediately the cock crew. (past tense)

Jesus brought before Pilate (Mt. 27. 1-14; Mk. 15. 1-5; Lk. 23. 1-7, 13, 16).

28 Then led they Jesus from Caiaphas unto the hall of judgment: and it was early, and they themselves went not into the judgment hall, lest they should be defiled; but that they might eat the passover.

29 Pilate then went out unto them, and said, What accusation bring ye against this man?

30 They answered and said unto him, If he were not a malefactor, we would not have delivered him up unto thee. **But no violation**

31 Then said Pilate unto them, Take ye him, and judge him according to your law. The Jews therefore said unto him, It is not lawful for us to put any man to death.

32 That the saying of Jesus might be fulfilled, which he spake, signifying what death he should die. - **Rom 8**

33 Then Pilate entered into the judgment hall again, and called Jesus, and said unto him, Art thou the King of the Jews?

Need a redeemer

19 The high priest then asked Jesus of his disciples, and of his doctrine. **Not answer About disc**

20 Jesus answered him, I spake openly to the world; I ever taught in the synagogues, and in the temple, whither the Jews always resort; and in secret have I said nothing.
