Hebrews 5: Christ is the only Glorified Priest

New Section: chap 5 - 10 (this is the longest section of Paul's epistle)

Topic: Priesthood of Christ rb - 2:17, 3:1, 4:14

Review: Jesus Christ is "The Son of God", and as such, he is superior to

The prophets (ch 1), the angels (ch 1-2),

Moses (ch 3), Joshua (ch 4),

In this chapter Paul teaches that Christ is superior to Aaron.

5:1-3 Opens with the contrast of the Levitical priests-

- (a) they represent men toward God in prayers and offerings e.g. Lev 1:7-8, 2:9
- (b) they also make offering for themselves Lev 4:3-4, 5:14-15

compare pagan priests: Babylon Mystery Religion, R. Woodrow, 1966 (chap 11)

Jesus Christ is a Great High Priest for seven reasons:

1. 4:14 He is the Son of God = his divinity
2. 4:15, 5:5 " without sin...glorified...holy (7:26) = his humanity
3. 5:6 " after the order of Mechisedec (i.e. to all mankind)

4. 7:20-21 He was made a priest with an oath from God
5. 9:14-15 He offered the perfect blood sacrifice

6. 7:25 He provides access to God in heaven

7. 7:24 He has an eternal, unchangeable priesthood
