Spiritual Gifts Romans 12:6–8

There is an organic unity in the body of Christ. The differences we have are not obstacles but the Holy Spirit uses them to enhance the oneness of the body of Christ.

A Spiritual Gift is a God given ability and enablement for the work of ministry in the church.

- 1. Miraculous: fully developed abilities used without training or human effort Sign gifts: given to and through the Apostles to establish the church.
- 2. Non-miraculous: abilities that need to be developed and learned Ministry gifts: given to every believer to serve and grow the church.

Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given

- The different gifts of the Holy Spirit make up the diversity of the body of Christ.
- The unity comes through each member using their gift for the benefit of the body.

if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith;

- The Holy Spirit given ability to speak the word of God into the lives of others.
- The person with this gift must be careful that he or she speaks only the things they
 clearly understand that have been revealed in the Scriptures.

or ministry, let us use it in our ministering;

- The Holy Spirit power to serve others within the body of Christ.
- Be in the sphere of serving and not somewhere else. Be absorbed in serving in order to free up others to exercise their gifts.

he who teaches, in teaching;

- The Holy Spirit will give some the ability to communicate the truths of God's word so as to be comprehended.
- Teaching must be biblical, doctrinal, and precise.

he who exhorts, in exhortation;

- The ability to encourage and urge someone to live the Christian life.
- The Holy Spirit ministers His comfort and encouragement through this gift.

he who gives, with liberality;

- The Holy Spirit enables someone to give beyond their ability.
- The Holy Spirit will give wisdom about how to give effectively.

he who leads, with diligence;

- The ability to lead people within the church.
- Effectively leading others to fruitful ministries and fulfilled callings.

he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.

- Some believers are gifted with a special concern and compassion to help others.
- Showing compassion without becoming hardened or demeaning.

We discover our gifts when we are sacrificing ourself in service to the body of Christ.


