Romans 16

Greetings (vv1-16)

- A small but precious window into the life of the early church.
 - Women in ministry and in the church
 - Eg. Phoebe
 - Commendations from Paul

- Diversity
 - ...in race; in class; in gender

- o "apostles" "sent ones"
 - There are <u>Apostles</u> and there are <u>apostles</u>.
- Early Church Structure
 - House churches

Watch Out! (vv17-20)

- ...for those who cause division
- ...for those who create obstacles
 - o ...for those who "are not serving our Lord Christ, but their own appetites" (v18).
- How can we tell who to stay away from?
 - They teach and do what is "contrary to the teaching you have been taught." (v17).
 - o By their "smooth talk and flattery"
 - Measure what they say against the gospel!
 - They serve themselves, not Christ (v18)

- "Be wise about what is good, and innocent about what is evil" (v19)
 - o Keep on learning, and refuse to have anything to do with evil.
 - Does it agree with Scripture?
 - Does it glorify the Lord Jesus?
 - Does it promote goodness?
- "The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet" (v 20).
 - The deceiver and divider will soon be destroyed!
 - Under YOUR feet!
 - Daily... and definitively...

More Greetings... (vv21-24)

- this time, from those in Corinth with Paul, to Rome

Glory to God - Doxology (vv25-27)

- God is able to strengthen/establish you
 - The gospel is not only the entry point into the Christian life; it is also the way we continue in, grow in and enjoy life with Christ. (Tim Keller)
- How?
 - o ...according to the gospel
 - ...according to the preaching of Jesus Christ
 - ...according to the revelation of the mystery
 - ...according to the command of the eternal God
 - to bring about the obedience of faith.
