

# "Mending Relationships"

Three (3) Keys Genesis 44:1-17

#### Being:

I. Respectful - "Is not this in which my lord drinketh" (vs. 1-6)

Appreciating their:

- A. Treasure "my cup, the silver cup"
- **B.** Time "As soon as the morning was light"
- C. Talents "whereby indeed he divineth"

II. Responsible - "With whomever... it be found" (vs. 7-13)

Acknowledging our:

- A. Principles "God forbid that thy servants...do...this thing"
- B. Practice "Behold, the money...we brought again"
- C. Pride "Then they rent their clothe... and returned to the city"

III. Repentant - "how shall we clear ourselves" (vs. 14-17)

Authenticating with:

- A. Remorse "they fell before him on the ground"
- B. Recognition "God hath found out the iniquity"
- C. Restitution "we are my lord's servants, both we and he"

### Sentence Sermon:

"Forgiveness is the needle and humility is the thread that mends relationships woven by love."
