 - a. Emotionally charged situations and circumstances
Matthew 20:20-27
 - b. Physically, emotionally, spiritually exhaustion
Proverbs 25:28
 - c. Losing sight of God's sovereignty
Genesis 50:15-21
4. What loveless irritability does in relationships?
 - a. With people: Desensitizes us toward them: Philippians 2:19-21
 - b. With God: Numbers 14:1-11
5. How is loveless irritability defeated?
 - a. Keep watch over ourselves
Matt. 26:41, Prov. 4:23
 - b. View people as image-bearers – not irritants

 - c. Remember God is constantly at work in us
