# The Blessing of God's Appointed Authority

### Key Idea:

Godly authority serves God's people sacrificially to bring the blessings of God's life-giving favor.

To reject God's appointed leaders/High Priest is to reject God's authority and to forfeit your life.

# Godly Rulers, Pastor/Elders & Fathers...

- Authority: the power or <u>right</u> to give orders, make decisions, and enforce obedience. Vs. Power: the ability to do something
  - Households
  - Civil Government
  - o Church

<sup>7</sup> **Remember your leaders**, those who spoke to you the word of God. <u>Consider the outcome of their way of life</u>, and <u>imitate their faith</u>. ...

17 <u>Obey</u> your leaders and submit to them, for <u>they</u> are keeping watch over your souls, as those who will have to give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with groaning, for that would be of no advantage to you.



<sup>3</sup> They assembled themselves together *against Moses and against Aaron* and said to them,



"You have gone too far! For *all in the congregation* are holy, every one of them, and the Lord is among them. Why then do you exalt yourselves above the assembly of the Lord?"

Notes:

- ➢ God is with us. <u>We</u> all are Special. We can all approach God on our own (no need for the priests God appointed).
- <sup>6</sup> Do this: take censers (Lev. 10), Korah and all his company; 7 put fire in them and put incense on them before the Lord tomorrow, and the man whom the Lord chooses shall be the holy one. You have gone too far, sons of Levi!" 8 And Moses said to Korah, "Hear now, you sons of Levi: 9 is it too small a thing for you that the God of Israel has separated you from the congregation of Israel, to bring you near to himself, to do service in the tabernacle of the Lord and to stand before the congregation to minister to them, <sup>10</sup> and that he has brought you near him, and all your brothers the sons of Levi with you? And would vou seek the priesthood also? 11 Therefore it is against the Lord that you and all your company have gathered together. What is Aaron that you grumble against him?"

# (Dathan and Abiram) Reuben's Rebellion (12-15)

And Moses sent to call Dathan and Abiram the sons of Eliab, and they said, "We will not come up. <sup>13</sup> Is it a small thing that you have brought us up out of a land flowing with milk and honey, to kill us in the wilderness, that you must also make yourself a prince over us? <sup>14</sup> Moreover, you have not brought us into a land flowing with milk and honey, nor given us inheritance of fields and vineyards. Will you put out the eyes of these men? We will not come up." <sup>15</sup> And Moses was very angry and said to the Lord, "Do not respect their offering. I have not taken one donkey from them, and I have not harmed one of them."

<sup>41</sup> But on the next day all the congregation of the people of Israel *grumbled against Moses and against Aaron*, saying, "You have killed the people of the Lord." <sup>42</sup> And when the congregation had assembled *against Moses and against Aaron* 

# The Plague & God's Mediator

[The LORD...Moses & Aaron] <sup>45</sup> "Get away from the midst of this congregation, *that I may consume them in a moment*." And they fell on their faces. <sup>46</sup> And Moses said to Aaron, "Take your censer, and put fire on it from off the altar and lay incense on it and carry it quickly to the congregation and make atonement for them, for wrath has gone out from the Lord; the plague has begun." <sup>47</sup> ...And behold, the plague had already begun among the people. And he put on the incense and made atonement for the people. <sup>48</sup> And *he stood between the dead and the living*, and the plague was stopped. <sup>49</sup> Now those who died in the plague were 14,700, besides those who died in the affair of Korah.

# The LORD Gives a Sign: Aaron's Staff Buds (17:1-13)

<sup>8</sup> ...Moses went into the tent of the testimony, and behold, the staff of Aaron for the house of Levi had sprouted and put forth *buds* and produced *blossoms*, and it bore *ripe almonds*.
