The Gospel According To Isaiah, Again
Isaiah 59

- I. God Can Save (1)
 - A. His arm (Jesus) is not too short
 - B. His ear is not too dull
 - C. Compare these with what comes next in verse 2
- II. Sin Is The Supreme Problem (2-8)
 - A. The power of sin
 - 1. To separate us from God (arm)
 - 2. To cause God not to hear (ear)
 - B. The picture of the sinner
 - 1. Does wickedness (hands/fingers)
 - 2. Speaks wickedness (lips/tongue)
 - 3. Social injustice
 - 4. Disregard for the truth
 - 5. Develops patterns of wickedness
 - C. Consequences
 - 1. Their path is crooked
 - 2. They do not know peace
- III. The Confession of the Wicked (9-15a)
 - A. We are not righteous
 - B. We are in darkness
 - C. We acknowledge our helplessness
 - D. We acknowledge our sin
- IV. God's Grace filled Response (15b-21)
 - A. God sees the true condition of things – only helplessness and evil
 - B. God Himself intervenes
 - 1. He will bring both righteousness and judgment
 - 2. The fear of the Lord

- 3. A redeemer will come
- C. The blessing the Redeemer brings
 - 1. Forgiveness for the repentant
 - 2. An everlasting covenant for the redeemed
