2. Where do you turn to overcome your anxiety and fears as you live in the midst of trouble times? As Christians, where should we always turn to renew our confidence and hope?
3. Regarding Psalm 2:
  - A. What is the basic message of this Psalm?
  - B. What is the encouragement and hope that Psalm 2 gives us in its Old Testament context?
4. Why is it important to interpret Psalm 2 in the book of Psalms or the Psalter? When we place Psalm 2 in the Psalter, how does it anticipate the coming of Christ?
5. How and when did our Lord Jesus fulfill Psalm 2? Please read: Acts 4:23-31; Acts 13:32-33; Hebrews 1:5; Hebrews 5:5.
6. In light of Christ's fulfillment on this Psalm in his coming, life, death, resurrection, and ascension, how should we think of Christ's kingship now as we live our lives and anticipate his second coming?
7. How does viewing Christ as the King of kings and Lord of lords encourage you in troubling times?
8. How should we live now as the church in light of Christ's fulfillment of Psalm 2? What does this tell us about the church's mission?
9. How are you going to live tomorrow in light of the truth of Psalm 2 now fulfilled in Christ?
