Consider & Discuss (Be Transformed!)

- **Community Group Discussion:** The gospel according to the Bible is different than the gospel most of us first heard. It is the gospel of resurrection, i.e., the good news of God bringing life out of death. *"Life Out of Death"* is a phrase that does greater justice to the biblical and more robust Gospel than the common conception and proclamation of the gospel in our day. Interestingly, Pastor Kit Culver points out that the Gospel of the Resurrection, the Gospel of Life out of Death has its origin in Jesus' incarnation. Jesus' incarnation begins God's final and ultimate activity to bring life out of death, and His resurrection is the climactic expression of that activity. How would you explain that the incarnation is the origin of resurrection?
