- 1- It is different than a relationship cf. 3:11; 4:1
- 2- It is a process of growth cf. 4: 1b, 1 Thess. 3: 13
- 3- It is a "walk" with God cf. 4:1c
- 4- It is pleasing to God cf. 1c
- 5- It is accompanied by commands cf. 4: 2
- 6- It is the will of God
- 7- It is synonymous with "sanctification



What is Fellowship with GOD:

B. Summary:

Fellowship with God is for those who have received eternal life through Faith in Christ, and enjoy the "abundant life" that is found only in Him.

(see Jn. 10:10)

1 Corinthians 3:13-17 (NKJV)

13 each one's work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the fire will test each one's work, of what sort it is. 14 If anyone's work which he has built on it endures, he will receive a reward. 15 If anyone's work is burned, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire. 16 Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? 17 If anyone defiles the temple of God, God will destroy him. For the temple of God is holy, which temple you are.



Galatians 5:13-17 (NKJV)

13 For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. 14 For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." 15 But if you bite and devour one another, beware lest you be consumed by one another! 16 I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. 17 For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish.
