Amos 3 Two Can Walk Together!

- v 1 "Hearken" phrase = 3:1, 4:1 & 5:1 [i.e. three sermons]

 Amos preaches that God has a controversy with His people, Hosea 4:1
- v 2 Personal knowledge, hx: Exo 19:5, Deu 4:20 contrast Mt 7:23 spir: God knows everything, 1 Chron 28:9 and everyone, Mt 10:30 doct: God only relates to those who are "in Christ" (i.e. his Son).

 God's Son only knows His sheep, John 10:14 Psalm 1:6

 Christ denies the rest, Mt 7:23

Israel was God's people, a peculiar people.

Yet God had something against them.

He made a covenant with them, He gave counsel, prophets, comfort and provision to them. Though He had spoken many times to them they would not regard His counsel.

So now they will be made to hear rebuke and threatenings of judgment!

spiritual truth : Privilege brings responsibility (not immunity, unaccountability, or exemptions)

- v 3-6 God asks seven rhetorical questions. Answer to all: No!

 They had walked away from God (i.e. *contrary* to God's laws), 1 Kings 12:28-31

 They had been warned against a contrary walk, Lev 26:14, 23-24

 God cannot walk with a church that walks with other 'gods'.

 God cannot walk with a 'Christian' who walks after the flesh.

 God cannot walk with 'bibles' written by the devil.
- v 7 Prophet's knowledge Pr 3:32 Ps 25:14, 19:7-9 e.g. Abraham Gen 18:17

 Jer 20:8-9 Acts 4:18-20 1 Cor 9:16
- v 8 the lion hath roared ... i.e. judgment must come 1 Peter 4:17 why? Their sins grieve God...they dishonour God! Therefore He will punish them.
- v 11 adversary hx: Assyria 2 Kings 17 doct: the antichrist
- v 12 piece of an ear ~ Isa 6:13
- v 14 I will visit the altars of Bethel 2 Kings 23:15
- v 15 I will smite ... your selfish, indulgent excess

hx: houses of ivory ~ I Kings 22:39 e.g. king Ahab winter house ~ Jer 36:22

spir:: Luke 12:15-21
