# **CONFIDENCE IN THE LORD CONCERNING YOU - Part 1 - 2 Thes 3:3-5**

### INTRODUCTION

- 1. <u>2Thes 3:3-5</u> God's Preserving Grace & Xn's Perseverance.
  - i. v4 we have confidence in the Lord [Ps 100:3].
  - ii. v4 concerning you that you will do & will con't to do

## 1st: Paul Expects God to Preserve Christians & Christians to Persevere.

- 1. God's sov'ty & man's responsibility are stitched together in Xn life.
- 2. Divine sovereign love explains a "Xn". Salvation by Triune God.
- 3. Disciple's submissive love explains a "Xn".
- **4.** Why are you a Xn? "B/c God loves me!" B/c B/c I love Jesus." [1Jn 4:19; Jn 14:15; 15:10a].
- 5. Paul weaves divine preservation w/ disciple's perseverance. Context.
  - i. commends perseverance 1:3.4
  - ii. preserving grace 1:11-12 v3 thank God for you according to grace
  - iii. preserving grace 2:13-14 Panoramic vista of salvation
  - iV. call to persevere 2:15
  - V. preserving grace 2:16-17
  - Vi. pray for preserving grace- 3:1-3
  - VII. preservation & perseverance 3:4-5
  - VIII. commands perseverance 3:6 protect church [1Th 5:14; 2Th 3:14-15]
  - iX. commends preserving grace 3:16 benedictory prayer
- 6. Live the Xn life dutiful discipleship & dependent on Spirit Phil 2:12-13
  - i. Jesus [Jn 15:4-5]
  - ii. Paul Col 1:29; Phil 4:13; Gal 2:20
  - iii. Peter 1Pt 4:11
- 7. The life of faith supernatural grace Hab 2:4 Hb 10:38. Hb 11

#### 2nd: Paul's Confidence in the Context of Persecution

- 1. Paul is *confident*. Should he be? <u>A 17:1-10</u> History of Paul in Thess.
- 2. He recalls ministry in 1Th 2 tender mother & exhorting father. Also the opposition. His concern was assuaged by arrival of Tim 1Thes 2:14-3:8.

### 3rd: What Gave Paul Confidence?

- 1. Reception of Word of God <u>1Th 1:2-5a</u>; <u>1Th 2:13</u>; <u>2Th 3:4,6,12,14,17</u>
- 2. Enduring persecution <u>1Th 1:6; 2:14; 3:3; 3:7-8; 2Th 1:4-5</u>
- **3.** Churchmanship 1Th 1:1 1:3; 1:8; 2:14; 3:6; 4:9-10; 5:11-15; -- 2Th 1:1 1:2-4; 3:6 v14 associate = social fellowship => rlnshp to the church
- 4. Confident in Lord 1Th 1:4; 4:8-9 taught to love; 5:9; 5:24 -- 2Th 3:4

## 4th: Paul's Confidence in the Prospect of Final Judgment

- 1. THE doctrinal emph re: 2nd coming & FJ. Practical instruction is given in view of coming of Jesus, FJ & eternity = evangelical rxn to opposition.
  - i. Paul knew *city authorities* complied w/ mob at instigation of those from synagogue, but not urge political rxn persevere, Christ is coming
  - ii. Paul & church persecuted 2 Thes 1:3-10 Day of judgment is at hand.
- 2. God's court-room not try to get courts of men to justify us.
  - i. <u>1Th 1:9-10; 2:19-20; 3:13;</u> 4:13-18 [ FJ]; <u>5:9</u> [contra 3:3]; <u>5:23</u>
  - ii. 2Th [1:3-10 & 2:1-12 2nd coming & FJ]; 2:14
- 3. Are we hearing Xn "cultural influencers" advocate this approach?

- 1. Thanksgiving <u>1Th 1:2</u>; <u>2:13</u>; <u>3:9</u>; --- <u>2Th 1:3</u>; <u>2:13</u>
- 2. Entrusting to the Ld <u>1Th 3:11-13</u>; <u>5:23</u> --- <u>2Th 1:11-12</u>; <u>2:16-17</u>; <u>3:16,18</u>
