

**"The Veil"** Holiness Required **Exodus 26:31-37** 

Jesus offers us a:

I. **Propitiation** – "the mercy seat upon the ark" (vs. 31-34) It is about God's:

- A. Standard "the holy place and the most holy"
- B. Salvation "His own blood...obtained eternal redemption" Hebrews 9:12

C. Satisfaction – "He Himself is the propitiation for our sins" I John 2:2

II. Priesthood - "set the table without the veil" (vs. 35-36)

It's about being:

A. Servants – "accomplishing the service of God" Hebrews 9:6 B. Sanctified - "sanctified and meet for the Master's use" II Timothy 2:21 C. Spokespersons - "Go ye ... and preach the gospel"

Mark 16:15

**III.** Pathway - "an hanging for the door of the tent" (vs. 36-37) *It's:* 

A. Named – "none other name...whereby we must be saved" Acts 4:12
B. Narrow - "narrow is the gate ...that leads to life" Matthew 7:14
C. Neglected – "there are few who find it" <u>Sentence</u> Sermon:

"Jesus' death provides believers with direct access to God and His mercy."
