



## *“The Veil”*

*Holiness Required*  
*Exodus 26:31-37*

*Jesus offers us a:*

### **I. Propitiation** – “the mercy seat upon the ark” (vs. 31-34 )

*It is about God’s:*

**A. Standard** - “the holy place and the most holy”

**B. Salvation** – “His own blood...obtained eternal redemption”  
**Hebrews 9:12**

**C. Satisfaction** – “He Himself is the propitiation for our sins”  
**I John 2:2**

### **II. Priesthood** - “set the table without the veil” (vs. 35-36)

*It’s about being:*

**A. Servants** – “accomplishing the service of God”  
**Hebrews 9:6**

**B. Sanctified** - “sanctified and meet for the Master’s use”  
**II Timothy 2:21**

**C. Spokespersons** - “Go ye...and preach the gospel”  
**Mark 16:15**

### **III. Pathway** - “an hanging for the door of the tent” (vs. 36-37)

*It’s:*

**A. Named** – “none other name...whereby we must be saved”  
**Acts 4:12**

**B. Narrow** - “narrow is the gate...that leads to life”  
**Matthew 7:14**

**C. Neglected** – “there are few who find it”
