Joshua 22 — "Practical Lessons for Preserving Unity Among the People of God!"

How good & how pleasant it is for brothers to dwell in UNITY (Ps 133.1)

We are to actively serve one another until we all attain to the UNITY of the Spirit (Eph 4.13)

We are to be putting on love which is the perfect bond of UNITY (Col 3.14)

We must be DILIGENT to preserve the unity of the Spirit (Eph 4.3)

Christ's prayer is for us to be perfected in UNITY (John 17.23)

A Sure Path to Destroy Unity. The Way to Guarantee Conflict & Disharmony:

- 1. Act on hearsay and rumor!
- 2. React without checking the facts!
 - "He that answers a matter before he hears it, it is a folly and a shame unto him" (Proverbs 18:13).
- 3. Make accusations!
- 4. Bear false witness to others!

THESIS — 4 very practical lessons for us **SO that** we may preserve unity among the people of God!

I. PRIORITIZE OBEDIENCE! (1-9)

Note all the verbs (actions/emphasis!) in verse 5 — Be very careful to...

II.SHUN ACCUSATIONS! (10-20)

The building of the "altar" —

God is jealous for his own institutions; we should be so too, and afraid of every thing that looks like, or leads to idolatry. (Matthew Henry).

But! We must be careful: unguarded zeal without patience, humility, & gentleness can lead to disaster *quickly*!

Verses 10-12 — The downward spiral of accusations!

- 1. they *hear* about it (11a)
- 2. they *talk* about it (11b)
- 3. they make *assumptions* about it (v.11c)
- 4. they get *emotionally worked up* because of it (12a)

- 5. they go to war because of it (12b)
- 6. they make *accusations* because of it (vv.13-20)

Beware! Assuming motives in someone is an arrogant sin of 'playing God' because only God knows the motives.

"It is an act of loving care to believe good things about your brother until you have evidence to believe otherwise. This means we should read and listen to folks charitably and extend an assumption of good motives to them for as long as we can. In the Kingdom of Christ, relationships are too important to think the worst of people. Often we're tempted to jump to the worst possible scenario. Another way to frame this would be to treat others with the charity you would like to be treated (Matt 7:12)." (Heath Lambert)

III.RESPOND PATIENTLY! (21-29)

Prov 15.1 - a gentle answer turns away wrath

Prov 14.29 - he who is slow to anger has great understanding.

Prov 19.11 - a man's discretion/wisdom makes him slow to anger

James 1.19 - quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger!

❖ What can we learn when we're on the *receiving* end of being accused? 3 lessons!

- 1. Immediately **besech** your God (vv.21-22)
- 2. Honestly **affirm** your integrity (vv.23-25)
- 3. Humbly state your case (vv.26-29)

Prov 15.18 - the slow to anger calms a dispute.;

IV. CONTINUE HARMONIOUSLY! (30-34)

- The Israelite leaders hear their explanation, receive it, welcome it & reconcile peacefully, joyfully, & worshipfully!
- See what listening will do! They listen, they respond, they preserve unity (cf. James 1:19-20).

37 Ways to Love One Another

A local church is not built by one man, or even a few men, but by every believer being actively involved in ministry through evangelizing the lost people in their lives and serving their fellow Christians. A quick glance at the practice of the New Testament church reveals that they thought *very little* about programs and *very much* about relationships.

Consider the disciple-making that would naturally take place in the life of a local church if every believer would practice the loving, one-another ministry that the early churches first read about in the instructions they received from the apostles:

- 1. Be devoted to one another (Rom. 12:10).
- 2. Give preference to one another (Rom. 12:10).
- 3. Be of the same mind toward one another (Rom. 12:16).
- 4. Accept one another by withholding judgment (Rom. 14:1).
- 5. Accept one another by showing deference (Rom. 14:1–5; 15:7).
- 6. Esteem [highly regard] one another in love (Rom. 14:5; Phil. 2:3).
- 7. Build up one another (Rom. 14:19; 1 Thes. 5:11).
- 8. Counsel one another (Rom. 15:14).
- 9. Serve one another by showing deference in matters of liberty (Gal. 5:13).
- 10. Bear one another's sin burdens (Gal. 6:2).
- 11. Be gentle with one another (Eph. 4:2).
- 12. Be kind to one another so as to preserve unity (Eph. 4:32).
- 13. Speak truth to one another (Eph. 4:25; Col 3:9).
- 14. Submit to one another (Eph. 5:21).
- 15. Show compassion to one another (Col. 3:12).
- 16. Bear with the inherent sinfulness of one another (Col. 3:13).
- 17. Forgive one another (Col. 3:13).
- 18. Use Spirit-filled, Word-saturated music to teach and admonish one another (Col. 3:16; Eph. 5:19).
- 19. Comfort one another with the hope of Christ's return (1 Thes. 4:18).
- 20. Encourage one another (1 Thes. 5:11).
- 21. Live in peace with one another (1 Thes. 5:13).
- 22. Seek good for one another (1 Thes. 5:15).
- 23. Encourage one another to forsake unbelief and hardness of heart (Heb. 3:13).
- 24. Stimulate one another to spiritual growth (Heb. 10:24).
- 25. Encourage one another by faithful participation in your local church (Heb. 10:25).
- 26. Confess sins to one another (James 5:16).
- 27. Pray for one another's spiritual and physical healing (James 5:16).
- 28. Be long-suffering and patient toward one another (1 Peter 4:8; Eph. 4:2).
- 29. Be hospitable to one another without complaint (1 Peter 4:9).
- 30. Serve one another (1 Peter 4:10; Gal. 5:13).
- 31. Act in humility toward one another (1 Peter 5:5).
- 32. Show holy affection to one another (1 Peter 5:14).
- 33. Participate in the holy walk with one another (1 John 1:7).
- 34. Refuse to become resentful toward one another (1 John 3:11–12).
- 35. Give sacrificially to meet one another's needs (1 John 3:16–17).
- 36. Fight fear together by growing in love (1 John 4:18).
- 37. Walk in truth together (1 John 3:18; 2 John 1:5).

The Christian life is all about relationships. It's God's design for our personal growth, which then translates into church growth—the real kind. Loving one another is a powerful evangelistic tool, as Jesus says: "By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another" (John 13:35).

- Praise God the Spirit for His effectual, irresistible call, His regeneration, His sealing and securing us till glory.
- Praise God for His attributes (sovereignty, holiness, justice, love, mercy, righteousness, grace, omniscience, power, eternality, unchangeableness, faithfulness, self-existence)

2. PETITION!

Sing: Give Me One Pure and Holy Passion

Give me one pure and holy passion.

Give me one magnificent obsession.

To know and follow hard after You,
To grow as Your disciple in the Truth,
This world is empty, pale, and poor
Compared to knowing You my Lord.
Lead me on, and I will run after You!
Lead me on, and I will run after You!

Pray:

- Pray through the one another's (see pages 3 & 4 for examples)
- Pray specifically for great hunger & passion for God.
- Pray for revival in *our* hearts, revival in our city, in our nation, across the world.

3. PREPARATION!

Sing: Soldiers of Christ Arise

Soldiers of Christ, arise, Leave no unquarded place, And put your armor on, No weakness of the soul, Strong in the strength which God supplies, Take every virtue, every grace, Through His eternal Son; And fortify the whole. Strong in the Lord of Hosts, To keep your armor bright And in His mighty pow'r, Attend with constant care, Who in the strength of Jesus trusts Still walking in your Captain's sight Is more than conqueror. And watching unto prayer.

Prav:

- Pray for humility & pray for gentleness & pray that we would be of the same mind!
- Pray for patience & pray for communication & pray for diligent preserving of peace!
- Pray for a spirit of "love believing the best" & not being quick to assume motives! Lead us not into temptation!
- Pray for preparation against the fiery darts of the Evil One that may come against us (Eph 6.10-20; 2 Cor 2.11).
