Eat dust Psalm 72:7-9; Micah 7:15-17; Isaiah 49:23

The first giving of the Gospel. (Romans 16:20, Galatians 3:16)

As God is cursing the serpent, and the devil behind him, he is proclaiming mercy and grace to Adam and Eve.

God punishes Eve
